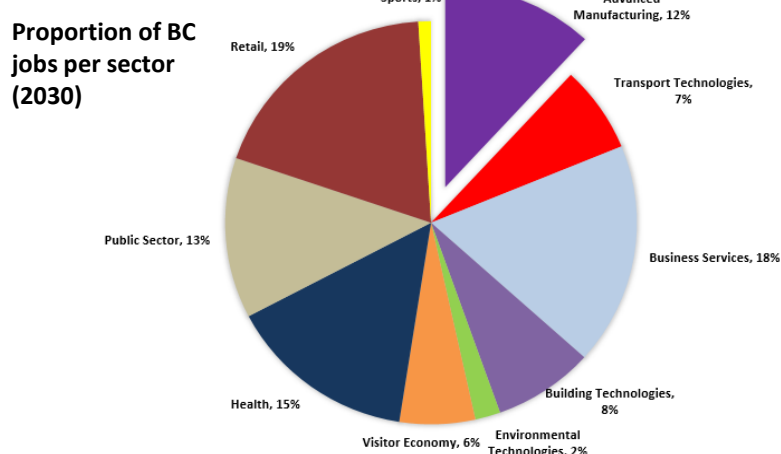
Transformational Sector: Advanced Manufacturing
