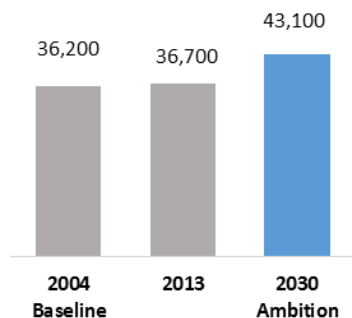
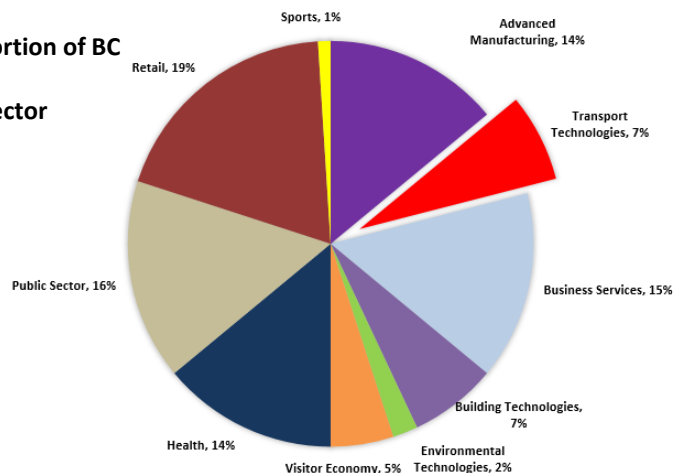

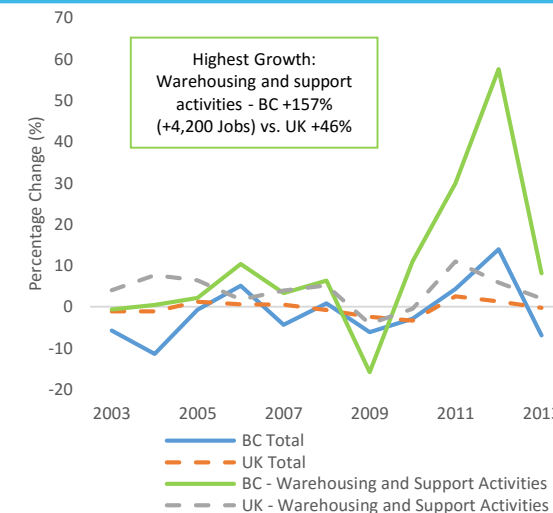
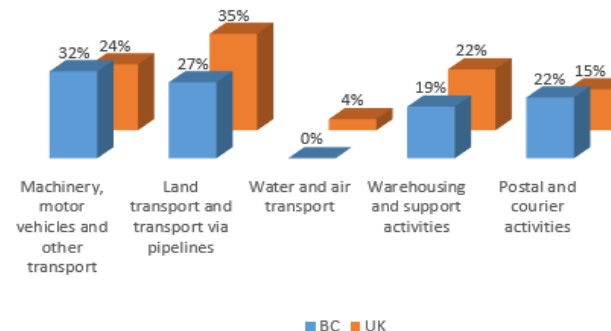

7% of BC total Jobs



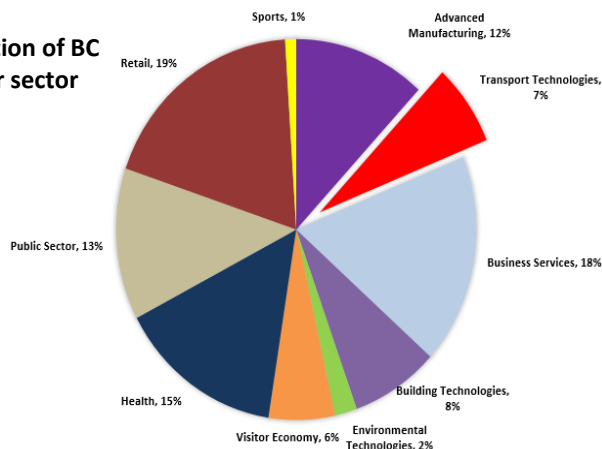

10,600 total requirement in BC transport and storage.

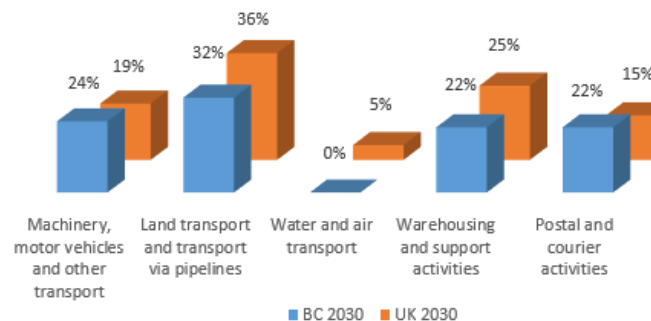
Proportion of BC jobs per sector (2030)
